## NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a special public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

## The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 15, 2024, at 1:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

- 1. Public comments (limit of 5 minutes per speaker);
- 2. Review and approval of the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Directors held on September 16, 2024;
- 3. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports and the payment of invoices presented;
- 4. Annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution in connection therewith;
- 5. Status of compliance by the District with Texas Government Code, Chapter 2265, relative to energy reporting;
- 6. Receive Tax Assessor-Collector report and approve payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;

- (e) Act upon any other matters in connection with the issuance of the Bonds, including the approval and execution of various closing documents and authorization for Bond Counsel to approve closing on the sale of the Bonds;

    - (vi) Overflow Clearing and Grubbing South (Trahan Construction, LLC); and
    - (vii) Overflow Clearing and Grubbing West (Trahan Construction, LLC);
  - (c) Acceptance of deeds, easements, and conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District; authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295's in connection therewith, including:
    - (i) Conveyance and Bill of Sale of Facilities Parkland Village, Section 46 Landscape Improvements; and
    - (ii) Conveyance and Bill of Sale of Facilities Parkland Village Emerald Lake Landscaping;
  - (d) Status of Storm Water Quality Permits; and
  - (e) Status of permanent water transfer capabilities between Inks Lake and the Trio Lakes;
